



On recommendation from the Our Saviour's Health Advisory Team, the church council approved the following changes to our COVID reopening plans on March 11, 2021. The changes will take effect as soon as staff can implement procedures. Please contact the church office if you lead an Our Saviour's group and are interested in scheduling an in-person meeting.

- Worship
 - Limited indoor in-person worship will continue to be held with existing guidelines, but capacity will be increased to 125
 - Registration is recommended but not required

- Group Meetings
 - We will be opening to Our Saviour's group meetings with the following guidelines:
 - All participants will sign in and answer the screening questions
 - Must wear masks and stay socially distanced (6 feet apart) at all times
 - Seating accommodations in the gathering area, maximum capacity of 20. Other areas as approved by staff.
 - No food or shared beverages. Participants can bring in their own coffee/water bottle.
 - A group leader will need to meet with a designated staff person to go over meeting guidelines before beginning to schedule meetings.
 - We are holding off on opening to community groups this month. Will be reviewing this recommendation periodically

- Funerals
 - We will be opening to funerals following the same guidelines as worship (screening questions, masks, social distancing, no fellowship time)
 - 100 participants capacity
 - Can accommodate the service only, no visitations at this time
